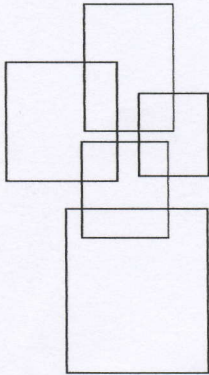
Jim Cromwell owes his daughter Holly Cromwell £100! The HOME magazine wonders what she'll do with it and whether Jim will ever give up and give her the money.
